- 1959 ➤ Graduated from the Faculty of Law
- 1964 ➤ Doctor's Degree in Law at Cluj; Professor of Law at the Social and Political Sciences Academy; at the School of the Ministry of the Interior; Professor of International Law (Human Rights and the Law of the Sea)
- 1965 till 1968 ➤ Chairman of the National Sub-Commission for Inquiring into abuses and illegalities
- 1970 till 1974 ➤ Scientific Director of the Institute of Political Sciences, Bucharest
- 1974 ➤ Visiting Professor, Columbia, Harvard, Berkeley, Universities
- 1975 till 1986 ➤ Legal Adviser in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Representative of Romania to the Law of the Sea Conference
- 1983 – 1988 ➤ Member of the United Nations Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, Geneva
- 1978 till 1985 ➤ Representative of Romania to the Sixth (Legal) Committee of the General Assembly of the United Nations
- 1985 till 1993 ➤ United Nations Special Rapporteur on Human Rights and Youth
- 1986 till 1989 ➤ He was kept in detention for his critical Report on Human Rights in Romania
- 1988 – 1989 ➤ The International Court of Justice at Hague judged his case and – through Decision 81/ 15 December 1989 – asked the Romanian authorities to free him, underlining that he is enjoying the United Nations' diplomatic immunity
- 1989 till 1990 ➤ Vice – President of Romania, after the Romanian Revolution
- 1991 ➤ Doctor Honoris Causa by A.C. of Switzerland for promotion of Human Rights
- 1991 to date ➤ Professor of International Law (Human Rights and the Law of the Sea)
- 1993 – 1994 ➤ Head of the Diplomatic Mission of Romania in Manila
- 1994 ➤ Ambassador in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- 1994 - 1997 ➤ Ambassador to the International Organizations in Vienna
- 1995 – 1997 ➤ Vice - Chairman of the United Nations Committee on The Peaceful Uses of Outer Space
- 1995 - 1997 ➤ Vice - President of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization
